The Quality Development Program

(QDP) is designed to provide entrylevel associates with exposure to multiple quality areas and BD business segments while broadening their experience and knowledge base. QDP Associates will spend the first three years of their career rotating through three different areas of Quality (New Product Development or Sustaining Engineering, Manufacturing Quality and Quality System or Quality Regulatory Compliance) throughout the US. In each rotation, the associate works closely with Quality Engineers as well as with cross functional partners (e.g. Manufacturing, R&D, Regulatory Affairs, Medical Affairs) growing their BD network
