

### **Recruitment Process/Application Questions**

#### How do I search for positions and apply?

Go to <u>www.nestleusacareers.com</u>. At the top of our website, you will find a search bar. Enter the location/position type that you are looking for, and click "search." Click on the link of the job that you are interested in, and you will be able to view the job description. After reviewing the job description, if this is a role you are interested in, scroll to the top of the job description page. At the top right, you will see a blue button that says "Apply." Click on the apply button, and you will be directed to create a profile and complete an application. A recruiter will then review your application, typically within two weeks.

#### How do I talk to a recruiter?

Applications are reviewed by function-specific recruiters. If interested in moving forward with your candidacy, the recruiter will contact you directly to schedule next steps.

#### I applied and didn't receive a reply?

As a first step, please be sure to check your spam folders, as sometimes our replies are redirected by your email provider.

Each application is typically reviewed by a member of the recruiting team within 2 weeks of receiving the submission. To check the status of your application, please return to our application site (<u>www.nestleusacareers.com</u>), then click "My Application Status" in the Search Bar at the top of the page, and log in. Information on candidate status is available directly within the candidate's My Jobpage / My Submissions on our Career's site.
