AVIATION MAINTENANCE TECHNICIANS

Performs production installations, maintenance, preventative maintenance, alterations and quality assurance on aircraft structure, systems and sub-systems, including electrical and avionics on standard or experimental certificated aircraft.

AIRCRAFT TEST TECHNICIAN

Performs functional testing, troubleshoot and rework/repair aircraft systems before, during, and after final assembly. Tests include electrical/electronic, pressure (+/-), hydraulic, and mechanical systems using diagnostic systems and PC-based and non-PC-based test equipment. Technicians must have knowledge of all aircraft systems and required test equipment.

ELECTRONIC MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN

Performs precision machine tool maintenance. Installs, maintains, troubleshoots, repairs and reworks electronic and associated electrical systems of precision machine tools and other precision manufacturing/production equipment.

MACHINE REPAIR MECHANIC

Repairs, overhauls, rebuilds and assembles a wide variety of plant equipment, including numerically controlled machines, precision-built machines, material handling equipment, and stationary generator sets.

MECHATRONICS MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN

Performs routine preventive and predictive maintenance on systems and equipment per manufacturer's specifications following defined, standardized processes, diagrams, sketches, operations manuals and engineering specifications.
