As a member of the test lab team, you will interact and work with other global distribution center planners In addition, you will analyze and manage materials to maintain enough supply according to forecast Interface with purchasing team to ensure required materials will be available when needed Create, analyze and distribute various reports regarding requirements, progress, and fulfillment issues Troubleshoot internal material issues Physically count and manage inventory levels.
