PURPOSE:

Seeking full-time Lab Sample Receipt Operatives to safely handle COVID19 samples prior to the distribution of them to the laboratory, maintain working consumable stock levels and ensure a free flowing working environment.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Responsible for the receiving and processing of clinical samples within the guidelines of the site working procedures.
- Take delivery of lab consumables and site working materials, maintaining a working stock level within each area.
- Splitting down and removing excess packaging reducing waste footprint within the building.
- On site porterage including removal of all waste from the lab areas and ensuring they are disposed through dedicated waste stream
- Timely transfer of samples from and to internal lab areas
- Maintenance of an organised and tidy sample receipt facility/working area
- Have the presence of mind to plan ahead and highlight potential issues.
- Updates management on all inventory issues on a regular and as-needed basis.

EXPERIENCE/REQUIREMENTS:

- Ideally stores or stock room knowledge
- Working within a team environment
- Have a sense of urgency when required
- Computer literate in basic programs

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to sit, use a keyboard, type, and occasionally stand and move to other parts of the lab.
- Must have manual dexterity to use lab equipment.
- Reach above/below the shoulder, bend at the knees and waist.
- Lift up to 25 lbs.

WORKING ENVIRONMENT:

- Clinical and research lab environment; exposure to blood borne pathogens; must wear protective lab gear including lab coat, gloves and completely closed footwear.
- Employee may be requested to work shifts other than daylight depending on the needs of the laboratory. Weekend rotation may be required.
- Travel is not required.
- Ensure safety, security, and the environment in all aspect of the daily activities, and any potential safety hazards are addressed and corrected immediately.
- Understand ergonomic relationship between people, equipment and working environment.
