



PREPARING FOR YOUR INTERVIEW



BEFORE YOUR INTERVIEW:

- Do research on the company.
- Prepare questions in advance for your interviewer.
- Practice translating military language before the interview.
- Relate your military experience to the job you're interviewing for.
- You can search keywords related to the job you're interviewing for to help draw connections from your military experience.
- Update your references.
- Bring extra copies of your resume in a folder or binder.



AT YOUR INTERVIEW:

- Dress to impress.
Business formal is always a safe route to go for an interview.
- Show up a few minutes early.
- Utilize the **S.T.A.R** method for interviewing:
 - Situation** - Describe the Situation.
 - Task** - Include the Task needed to be completed.
 - Action** - Tell your interviewer what Action you took.
 - Result** - Let them know the Result of that action.
- Don't forget to send thank you letters or emails to your interviewers.
