- O Do research on the company.
- O Prepare questions in advance for your interviewer.
- Practice translating military language before the interview.

- O Update your references.
- O Bring extra copies of your resume in a folder or binder.



- Dress to impress.
 Business formal is always a safe route to go for an interview.
- Show up a few minutes early.
- Utilize the S.T.A.R method for interviewing:
 Situation Describe the Situation.
 Task Include the Task needed to be completed.
 Action Tell your interviewer what Action you took.
 Result Let them know the Result of that action.
