Minimum Qualifications*

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Posses a High School diploma or GED.
- Ability to wear company-provided Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
- Pass the online Physical Test Battery (PTB) exam and the online Work Orientation Inventory Test (WOI).
- Possess a valid Class C Driver's License, ability to obtain a Class A Permit within 3 months and a Class A license within 6 months of hire.
- Ability to lift 50 pounds up to the waist level at least one time a day.
- Willing to work flexible shifts with extended hours.
- Once hired, pass random DOT drug testing.

*These minimum qualifications are required for most entry-level field roles. Additional requirements may apply depending on the specific role.
