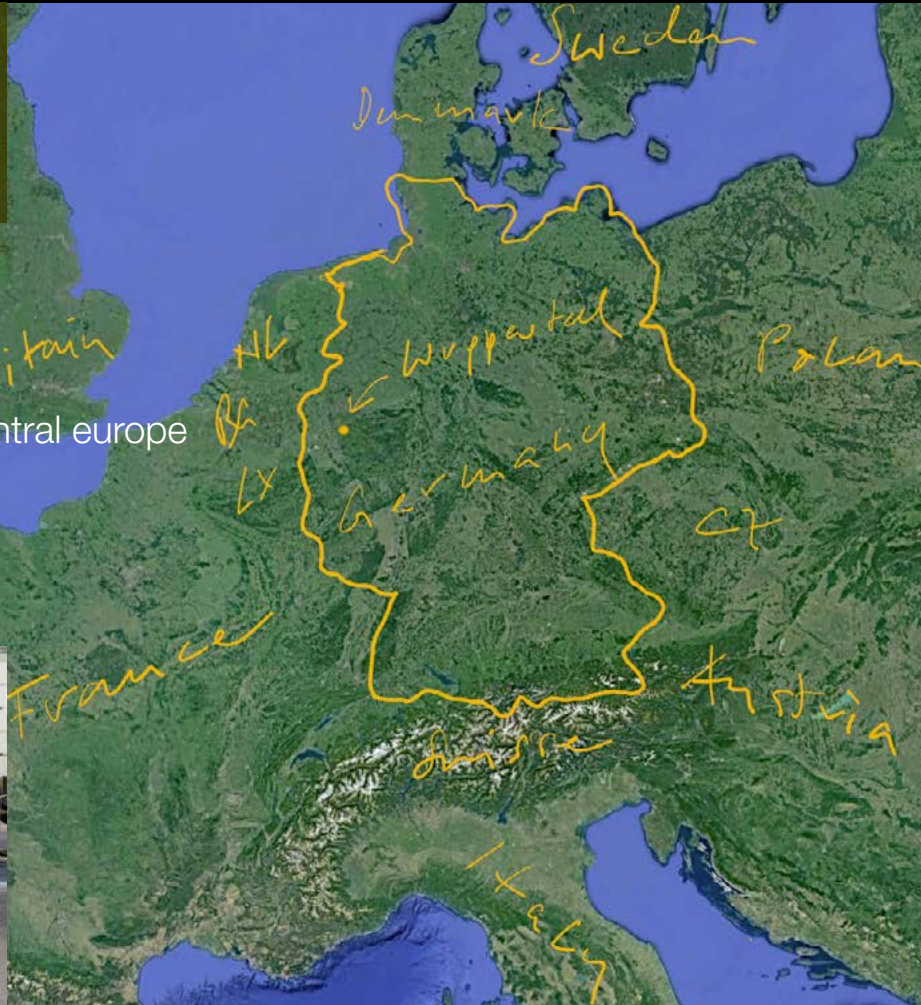

And the rents are pleasantly low in Wuppertal.

- While in Wuppertal everyone can eat and drink according to their fancy, the same goes for housing.
- The central city is dominated by traditional neighbourhoods with old buildings, such as “Nordstadt” shown in the photo, though almost all of them have been renovated inside and offer comfortable living space. Yet new, modern apartments are also on offer for those who prefer them.
- From hip to classy, from vibrant to totally quiet, in Wuppertal you can choose what kind of neighbourhood you wish to live in.
- Yet rental prices are considerably lower than in other large cities – you can rent for little money and spend more on pleasure. ;-)

WE'RE PROUD OF OUR **BAUMBESTAND***

*'Baumbestand' is our word for tree population. And we have a really huge one here.

- Wuppertal is the greenest „Großstadt“ (large city) in Germany. There is no other place where a park is within a shorter distance from any point in the city.
- Nature is a dominant feature not only in the region, but also in the city itself.
- That's great especially for families with children.
- The Wuppertal zoo is called “green zoo” and represents how the Wuppertal residents like to think of their city as green.
- Just a few kilometres from the city, our region, called “Bergisches Land”, offers pure nature. The wonderful landscape along Germany's largest river, the Rhine, is also within easy reach. That's just about as diverse as can be.
