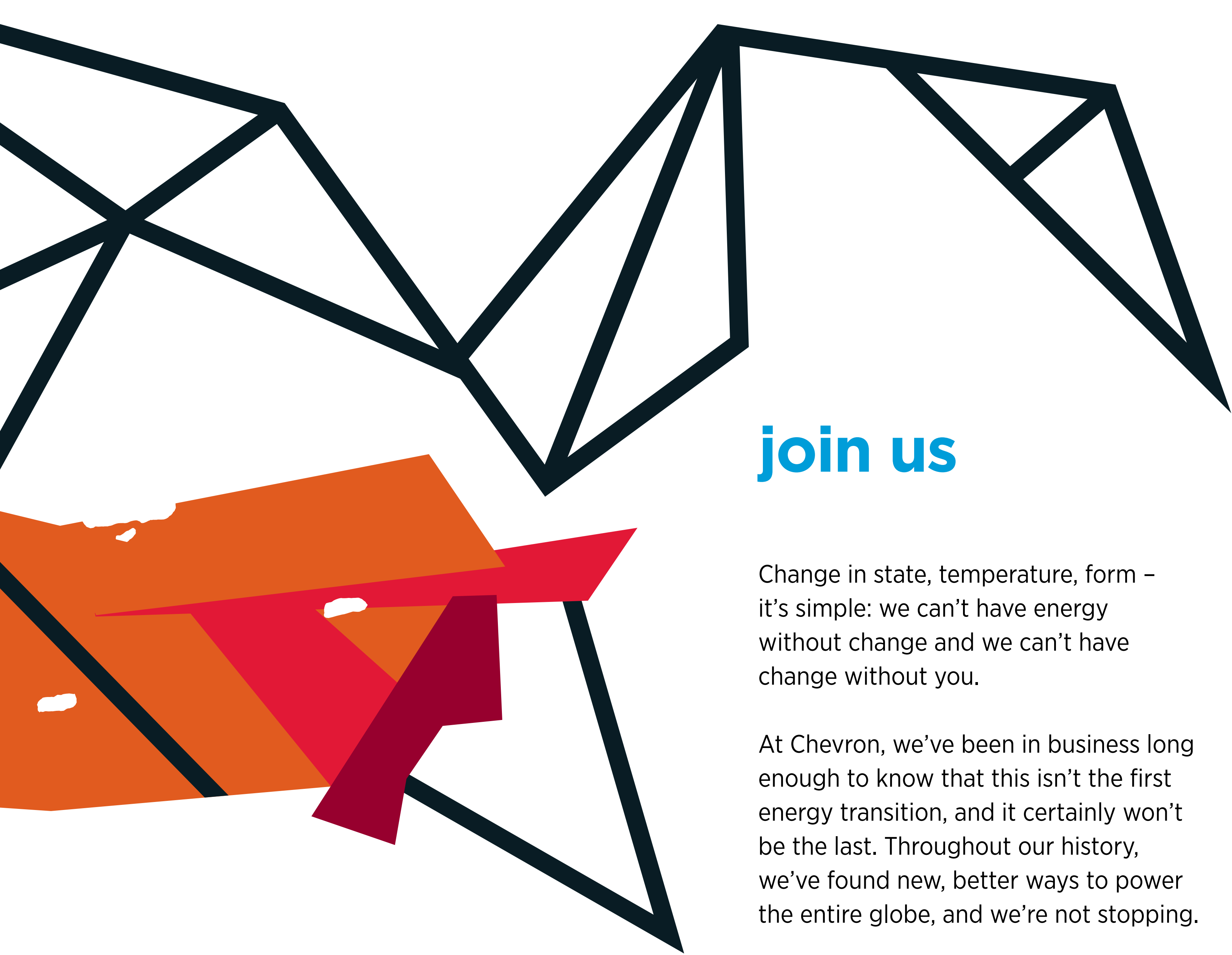

# we don't just talk the talk

Here are just a few ways in which we uphold these values every day:

- Chevron invests in Historically Black and Hispanic Serving Colleges and Universities, creates numerous scholarships and funds programs that improve access to education and professional development opportunities.
- We advance diverse talent through leadership development training and sponsorship programs.
- We lead an industry effort, hosted by the American Petroleum Institute, to increase demand for diverse suppliers from American Petroleum Institute companies, while increasing the capacity of Black-owned providers.
- We support minority business development networks, including the National Minority Supplier Development Council.
- 40% of the board at Chevron are women.
- In 2020, we invested \$40 million in women- and minority-owned businesses.
- We've invested more than \$1 billion in carbon capture, utilization, and storage (CCUS), reducing emissions by nearly 5 million tonnes per year. Our Gorgon facility is one of the world's largest integrated carbon sequestration and storage projects.
- Chevron has committed to net zero emissions by 2050.
- Chevron has twelve employee networks that connect our people across culture and ethnicity, gender, age, veteran status, LGBTQIA+ affiliation, and more.
