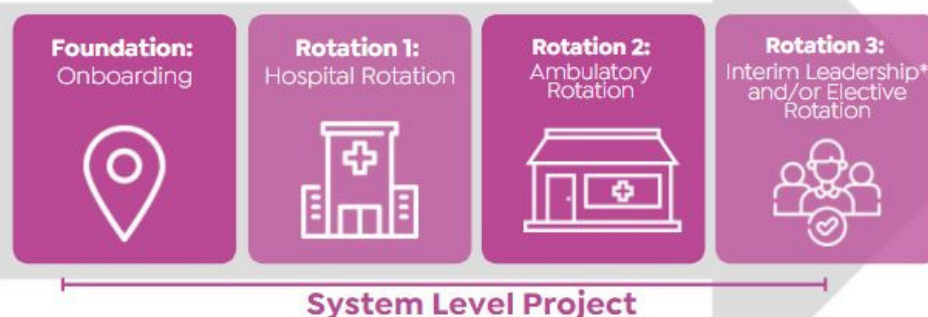


The future of health care leadership starts here.

*With the capability to change location based on opportunity

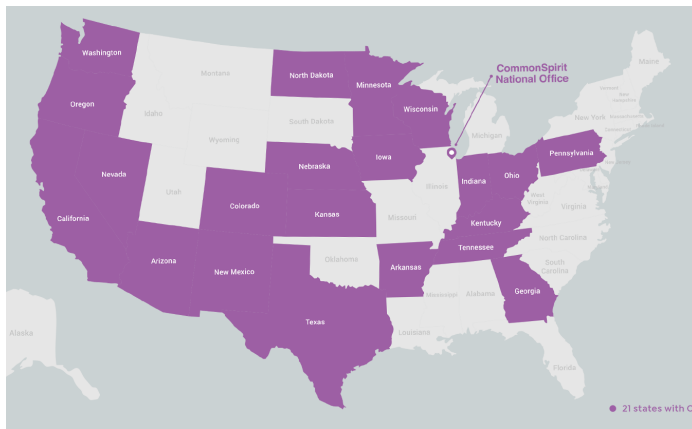
Administrative Fellowship Operations Track

The CommonSpirit Health Administrative Fellowship Operations Track will provide fellows with a broad range of health care experiences both at the national and local level. Fellows complete four rotations over the course of a year and a half to gain exposure and develop valuable skill sets in the hospital, ambulatory, and leadership functions within their divisions.

Locations

The 2022–2023 CommonSpirit Health Fellowship will be hosting nine Operations Track Fellows in the following divisions:

- Northern California: Dignity Health Sacramento, CA
- Midwest: CHI Health Omaha NE
- Pacific Northwest: Virginia Mason Franciscan Health Tacoma, WA
- Southeast(2): either CHI St. Vincent's Little Rock, AR, CHI Memorial Chattanooga, TN, or CHI St. Joseph Health Lexington, KY
- Southwest: Dignity Health Phoenix, AZ
- Southern California: Dignity Health, Los Angeles, CA
- Texas Fellows (2): St. Luke's Health Houston, TX



Eligibility

At the time of their application, candidates must either be currently enrolled in their last year of an accredited graduate program, will have completed upon conclusion of fellowship, or have recently completed* one of the below degrees from an accredited university:

- Master of Health Administration (MHA)
- Master of Business Administration (MBA)
- Master of Public Health (MPH)
- Master of Science in Nursing (MSN)
- Or equivalent degree from an accredited graduate program

Successful candidates will demonstrate interest in management opportunities within an integrated healthcare delivery system, a passion for the mission of CommonSpirit Health, and a commitment to being a provider of humankindness.

*recently completed: candidate has completed an applicable Master's degree within 1-2 years from the time of application.
