Public Transport

Route 21


This bus route operates between Gosford and The Entrance, passing through Bateau Bay along The Entrance Road. It provides connections to major destinations including Erina Fair Shopping Centre, Gosford Hospital, and Tuggerah Westfield.

Route 22

This route runs between Wyong and The Entrance, also serving Bateau Bay along The Entrance Road. It connects Bateau Bay to Wyong Station and Tuggerah Westfield.

Route 23

Route 23 operates between Gosford and Lake Haven, passing through Bateau Bay along Cresthaven Avenue. It provides access to Lake Haven Shopping Centre and Wyong Hospital.



These bus services offer a convenient way for residents and visitors to travel within Bateau Bay and to nearby areas. The bus stops are located along main roads like The Entrance Road and Cresthaven Avenue, making them easily accessible for commuters. It's important to check the Busways website or transport apps for updated timetables and route information, as schedules may vary depending on the time of day and day of the week.

For those commuting to Sydney or other locations, Bateau Bay is also accessible by car via the Pacific Motorway (M1), which connects to major cities and transport hubs on the Central Coast.



Bateau Bay does not have a train station or direct train services. The Central Coast region, including nearby suburbs like Gosford and Tuggerah, is served by train services operated by Transport for NSW's Sydney Trains and NSW TrainLink.

Tuggerah Station

Gosford Station

Airport

The nearest major airport to Bateau Bay, NSW, is Newcastle Airport (NTL), located approximately 100 kilometres north of Bateau Bay. Newcastle Airport is the closest commercial airport serving the Central Coast region and offers domestic flights to various destinations within Australia.

For international flights and a wider range of domestic connections, residents can also consider Sydney Kingsford Smith Airport (SYD), located approximately 115 kilometres south of Bateau Bay.



Schools




