

Fraudulent Activity

It has come to our attention that various individuals and organizations posing as recruiters from 7-Eleven, Inc. have contacted people offering false employment opportunities with 7-Eleven, Inc. or one of its brands including Speedway, Stripes, Laredo Taco Company, Raise the Roost Chicken & Biscuits, and SWTO. These persons have been offering fraudulent employment opportunities to applicants, often asking for sensitive personal and financial information as part of their fake recruiting process.

How to identify recruitment fraud:

1. All 7-Eleven jobs, including their family of brands, will be posted on our career site: <https://careers.7-eleven.com/>
2. 7-Eleven, Inc. will never ask for your personal financial or banking information or require any financial commitment as part of our candidate search or application process.
3. 7-Eleven, Inc. will not ask you to purchase equipment or supplies as part of your onboarding.
4. No job offers will be made at 7-Eleven, Inc. without a formal interview process.
5. If you receive an email from a sender that does not contain the @7-11.com address, please treat it as fraudulent.
