

Critical Care APP Fellowship

The Critical Care Fellowship is an elective 12-month postgraduate training program for acute care nurse practitioners (ACNPs) and physician assistants (PAs) interested in a career in critical care. The curriculum includes a year of supervised clinical training in various settings, including Surgical Critical Care, Neuroscience Critical Care, and Medical Critical Care, along with consulting services. Additional didactic training will focus on core competencies of critical care medicine, including simulation experiences, case scenarios, Fundamentals of Critical Care course, and other relevant curricula.

- Critical care boot camp
- Foundations of critical care
- Trauma/Surgical/Burn ICU
- Neurosurgical/Neurologic ICU
- Cardiothoracic/Vascular ICU
- Short rotations with off-service interdisciplinary teams that support the ICU mission
