

Interested Applicants

In partnership with Eversource, Local 369 UWUA, and Local 12004 USW, Bunker Hill Community College (BHCC) offers the Electric Power Utility Program (EPUT). Students accepted into this selective program can achieve a two-year accredited Associate of Science degree with the EPUT option. Students will conduct much of their laboratory training at an Eversource facility. Most classroom work will be conducted at BHCC.

The EPUT program has a fall start date. Potential candidates must apply in advance during the designated application period (application dates and deadlines are available on the Eversource's website at <https://jobs.eversource.com/student-programs#electric-power-utility>; generally, the application period is November through March for potential acceptance into the following fall's program). This is a two-year, fulltime day program regardless of a student's prior educational experience. In the two years in the program, students must participate in at least 10-12 weeks of paid internship during the summer and winter breaks of the program.

Steps for applying to the Electric Power Utility Technology Program:

- Complete a *BHCC admissions application* in its entirety and submit in person to B203 at BHCC. **Completed Applications must be received by March 29th 2019 for the September 2019 class.** Applicants will need two of the approved forms of identification for the In-State Tuition Eligibility Form. (Check the BHCC application for complete list.)
- Complete the *Eversource Electric Power Utility Technology Application* in its entirety and submit it to Bunker Hill by **March 29th 2019.**
- Students must have U.S. Work Authorization and be at least 18 years of age as of September 3, 2019 (for the 2019 class).
- Students are strongly encouraged to apply for financial aid. In order to qualify for financial aid, students must both apply to Bunker Hill Community College and complete a FAFSA (Free Application for Student Aid) online. Future candidates for the EPUT program initially apply as a General Concentration major (AA:GENCN) and must complete the FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov requesting a FAFSA report be sent to BHCC. BHCC's school code is 011210. Please contact the Financial Aid Office at (617)228-2275 for any questions regarding financial aid. **You can complete the FAFSA at any time during the application process!**

 - *Eversource's Electric Power Utility Technology Program Application*
 - High School/GED Requirements: Official Transcript. *High school seniors must submit a copy of their current high school transcript. High school seniors will be permitted to go through the application process provided that they submit a copy of their final transcript upon graduation but no later than July 1, 2019.*
- OR: College Official Transcripts
- A copy of your resume (optional)

If BHCC considers you to be academically eligible, your application will be forwarded to Eversource. Eversource will then contact you regarding additional testing and eligibility considerations, including a job skills pre-screen to test strength and ability, background checks (including a CORI, SORI, driving record, social media and a drug screening), and a potential interview at Eversource. Eversource will notify students by email of final acceptance into the program. A group orientation will be held at the college in August for accepted candidates, where class registration, school orientation and student payment will be covered.
