The scholarships available are for <u>tuition only</u> with amounts varying with respect to the area of study.

How to Apply

- 1. The application process is on-line and can be found on the McLeod Health website: jobs.mcleodhealth.org, and by typing *McLeod Health Scholarship* into the search bar.
 - a. When submitting the required documents, combine them into a **single PDF** and upload this into the 'resume' field.
- 2. All requested information must be submitted prior to the deadline to receive scholarship consideration. The open application periods are:
 - March 1st April 30th for internal and external students.
 - August 1st August 30th for internal students.
- 3. The McLeod Scholarship Coordinator will arrange a personal interview with a McLeod Health representative once all criteria have been met following the application deadline.
- 4. If approved, the scholarship recipient will receive an agreement to sign and the Financial Assistance Office at the school will be notified of the award.
- 5. The student will ensure that there is a completed Ferpa (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act) form on file with the school so that McLeod can be invoiced. The Scholarship Award money will begin the upcoming semester.

What Happens Upon Completion?

The scholarship recipient will apply for full-time employment with McLeod, at any of our campuses, in the area in which they were educated. If they are hired for employment with the organization, McLeod will forgive the scholarship at a set rate each month in which they work for McLeod Health. All McLeod Health scholarships require a work-off commitment. This commitment does not constitute a contract of employment and employment would be at will.

Receiving the scholarship does not automatically qualify a person for employment at McLeod Health. If the scholarship recipient is not offered or declines employment with McLeod Health within 90 days of graduation, the scholarship status will be in default.
